- **All stakeholders consulted, engaged, sensitised, and trained** (if needed)
- **Ownership** by direct and indirect project beneficiaries

- **Stakeholders from the public, private, university / research and civic sectors** involved in activities during and after the project
- **Well-designed Surveys** (baseline and endline), **agreed Impact matrix, participatory Monitoring and Evaluation, active Communication ...**
- **Mid and end-term reviews** of the project
- **Progress and impact tracking workshops and trainings**
- **Sociological dimension** included in impact measurement
- **Knowledge transfer linked, where possible, to commercialisation**
- **Public and private partnerships** to sustain project results
- **Degree of appropriation** of project results by potential users
- **Replicability potential of the project** to other themes, regions ...

- **Visibility and Communication methods aligned** with type of project results and target audience (on local, regional and continental level)
- **Creative and audience-adapted ways** applied to share information widely (channels, tools, contents, delivery, language ...)
- **Youth and local governments involved** in the use and multiplication of results
- **Interactions between producers and recipients of results**
- **Stakeholders trained** on communication on R&I
- **Surveys** to measure satisfaction of direct and indirect project beneficiaries
