As part of this dialogue, the European and African State Leaders have recently agreed to jointly develop an Innovation Agenda to translate results into tangible outputs.

The upcoming <u>European Development Days</u> (EDD) in June will also allow for discussions on concrete implementation of the new <u>European Global Gateway strategy</u> that focuses on boosting smart, clean and secure links in digital, energy and transport, and strengthening health, education and research systems across the world.

In today's world, the complexity of the most pressing challenges at both global and societal levels calls for coordinated R&I activities. I invite you to join us in developing and implementing such activities through enhanced commitment and lasting R&I partnerships.
