POLICY SUPPORT FACILITY

Reform Implementation Support Development of an Innovation Fund in The Gambia



OBJECTIVES

The PSF service aimed to assist the Ministry of Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology (MoHERST) in setting up and operationalising a National Innovation Fund, to accelerate The Gambia's transition to an innovation-led and knowledgebased economy.



METHODOLOGY

- Planning phase: a desktop review of relevant national and regional R&I documents to get key insights in the R&I system, its needs, challenges and recent developments.
- Field phase: information collection from a wide range of stakeholders (interviews and workshops).
- Closing phase: presentation of main recommendations during a validation event to foster ownershipand trust from a broad set of stakeholders.



MAIN RECOMMENDATIONS

- Launch the National Innovation Fund, as soon as possible;
- Ensure its funding through an annual flexible allocation by the Gambian government, leveraged by other national and international organisations and the private sector;
- Initiate an ambitious national programme (led by MoHERST);
- Enhance information flow and collaboration among universities, the public and private sector actors, and civil society;
- Increase national and international collaboration and encourage continuous learning from other countries (such as Botswana, South Africa, Mozambique, Rwanda, etc.).

NEXT STEPS

A National Research and Innovation Fund Bill has been approved for the operationalisation of the NIF.

Apart from the 3 M Dalasis (around 100k Euro) already allocated by the government to the National Innovation Fund -NIF, MoHERST is awaiting the endorsement by the Cabinet of additional resources.

MoHERST is also actively seeking new international partners to further expand the NIF.
